

Emergency and Care Supplies

Medical:

- Thermometer – digital
- Stethoscope – for heart rate and gut sounds (not absolutely necessary)

Bandaging:

- Vetrap – 4” (3-5 rolls)
- Elastikon – 3” (3-5 rolls)
- Gamgee roll padding (cotton padding with sheer covering so cotton doesn’t get stuck in wound)
- Telfa pads – to put directly on wound – won’t stick to wound
- Duct tape
- Davis boot – good for emergency soaking needs, bandage protection, etc. Need to be sure to get the correct size.
- Scissors with blunt end
- Baby diapers – great for wound compress
- Clean towels
- 4X4 gauze sponges

Wound care:

- Topical antibiotic cream such as Furacin or Nolvasan ointment
- Betadine solution and scrub for cleaning wound
- “Swat” – anti-fly ointment to put around open wounds

Medications:

- Phenylbutazone – only to be used under direction of your veterinarian
- Benadryl[®] (diphenhydramine) – only to be used under direction of your veterinarian
